What the Bible says about new years

Jewish Calendar has two new years

- 1. Religious Nisan March 15 ~ 14th Passover (~ March 29)
- 2. Civil Month of Tishri around September 15, Day of Atonement on 10th day (~ sep 25)

Passover

Exodus 12:1-14, 21-28

v11 The LORD's passover - not the israelites, but the Lord.

He's the one doing the judgment, he's the one who's willing to passover their sins if they want it

v27 - anything covered by the blood was saved

Day of Atonement - the ONE day a year the high priest could enter into God's presence and offer a sacrifice for the people for their forgiveness

Leviticus 16

High priest would take two goats and a bull.

The bull was sacrificed for his sin and his family

One goat would be chosen by lots to be the scapegoat -

one would be an alive offering that was allowed to go free, but to go into the wilderness - in a sense to carry the sins away out of sight and mind

THe other was sacrificed to God and his blood was sprinkled on the ark of the covenant, incense was to fill and cover the mercy seat that the priest wouldn't die.

Leviticus 23:26 - 32

And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying:

"Also the tenth [day] of this seventh month [shall be] the Day of Atonement. It shall be a holy convocation for you; you shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire to the LORD.

And you shall do no work on that same day, for it [is] the Day of Atonement, to make atonement for you before the LORD your God.

For any person who is not afflicted [in soul] on that same day shall be cut off from his people.

And any person who does any work on that same day, that person I will destroy from among his people.

You shall do no manner of work; [it shall be] a statute forever throughout your generations in all your dwellings.

It [shall be] to you a sabbath of [solemn] rest, and you shall afflict your souls; on the ninth [day] of the month at evening, from evening to evening, you shall celebrate your sabbath."

Psalm 103:12

As far as the east is from the west, [So] far has He removed our transgressions from us.

God's desire is to take our sins away, all our failures, shortcomings, screw ups and to give us a new life.
